Anna Edwards	Anna worked with Brownie and Junior troops to educate them about Canine Assistants and to help them earn their Animal Try-It or Pet Care badge. She collected items that Canine Assistants had on their wish list, cooked two meals for six recipients who were receiving a Canine Assistant dog and took a six week training class.
Maggie Hodges	Maggie helped the Atlanta Day Shelter for Women and Children by tending to their various needs such as gathering reading materials, school supplies, bookbags, and clothing for both women and children. She was also responsible for preparing and serving Christmas breakfast to over 50 women and children.
Katie Jorgensen	Katie solicited donations in her community for new yard equipment that would aim to benefit the new homeowners of the houses built by Habitat for Humanity volunteers and staff. She collected six "gift baskets" that included over twenty items such as trashcans, rakes, hoses, shovels, welcome mats, and watering cans to be given to the new homeowners. In addition, she also wrote a fifteen page guide book to help homeowners maintain the polished look of their new homes. Katie presented her gift baskets and books to the Habitat homeowners with Clark Howard on his radio program.
Lealan LaRoche	Lealan collected "in style" clothing items for teens from donations made to Plato's closet, and donations from peers, family, neighbors and other philanthropic organizations. After sorting and organizing the donations, she washed, sewed, altered, and repaired the clothing items and took them to the North Georgia Foster Parents Support Group in Roswell. Children and youth in foster care were allowed to choose any item of clothing for free, and Lealan greatly improved the shop's inventory.
Brittany Sanders	Brittany collected travel size toiletries for the Battered Women's Shelters of the Atlanta area. By writing letters to national and local businesses, and collecting items from church members, she was able to provide over 3,100 packaged toiletries and encouragement cards that were ready for distribution around the metropolitan Atlanta area.
Lehne Slater	Lehne's project was to tackle a major beautification project at Dunwoody High School. This project involved landscaping, decorating, and renovating the teachers' lounge.
