

High Harbour Adult Guidelines for Dunwoody Girl Scout Weekends

All parents attending a Girl Scout High Harbour weekend are Girl Scout representatives and therefore must adhere to Girl Scout rules and regulations and YMCA High Harbour rules and regulations.

It's important for all adults chaperoning the High Harbour trip to keep in mind – you are setting the example in both attitudes and actions. You have immense influence in the lives of these girls.

Specifically, all Girl Scout Leaders, Camping Parents, First Aiders and chaperones must adhere to the following:

1. Once you check-in at camp, stay at camp. Do not leave the camp unless you have a medical or family emergency. Specifically, do not leave camp for dinner Friday evening – bring dinner to camp or eat before you check-in.
2. As a courtesy to our group, the High Harbour staff designated the parking lot as the smoking area. This area is away from campers. (Note: High Harbour staffers are not permitted to smoke.)
3. Alcohol is prohibited at High Harbour.
4. Weapons of any kind are prohibited at High Harbour.
5. Because rule violations puts future Dunwoody Girl Scout weekends in jeopardy, adults are expected to report abuses to the camp director.

If any Girl Scout leader, chaperone or camper abuses any of the aforementioned rules, they will be sent home along with their entire troop.
